

Notice of Road Closure from St Clair Township:

I am writing you to advise your community that the Township of St. Clair is planning to rehabilitate a concrete box culvert on LaSalle Line between Ladysmith Road and Tecumseh Road. The project will require a complete road closure that will be impassable to traffic for approximately 3-4 weeks beginning Monday, October 17, 2016.

The contract was awarded to Finnbilt General Contracting from Stratford.

Local access to Degurse Drive and Scott Road (from the west), and McGregor Road (from the east) will remain accessible at all times.

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Notice of Upcoming Roadwork on Lasalle Line:

In the coming weeks, Lambton County has arranged to have the Marsh Creek culvert on Lasalle Line replaced.

Starting October 17, 2016 informational signs will be posted on Highway 40, on both northbound and southbound sides, as well as along St. Clair Parkway, also both northbound and southbound sides. They will indicate Lasalle line will be closed for roadwork.

The replacement work is scheduled to begin on October 31, 2016 for a period of 3 weeks. The time frame for the work may vary, depending on days lost due to the weather. Once the roadwork is to begin, signage will be posted indicating "Road Closed" at Highway 40/Lasalle, as well as at St. Clair Parkway/Lasalle Line. Additional signage, "Road Closed-Local Traffic Only" will be posted at Tashmoo/Lasalle and again at South Vidal/Lasalle.

City fire, police, school buses and garbage collection companies will be notified. The Aamjiwnaang bus driver will also be notified.

Shell may have their shutdown workers entering and leaving their parking area on Lasalle Line during a portion of the roadwork. Shell representatives have been advised of traffic concerns. Namely, workers using S. Vidal as a preferred traffic route. Shell will advise the workers to use St. Clair Parkway as the primary route to enter/exit the area.

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
