



2019 YMCA Project North – Questions & Answers

Q: Challenge Overview

A: YMCA Project North is a six-month leadership development program. Participants will meet weekly and challenge themselves in various leadership scenarios. The participants will also be engaged in various community events as they fundraise for their final challenge, an opportunity to connect with our cultural heritage across the country.

Q: Who can apply?

A: Youth who are in high school during the 2018/2019 school year are eligible to apply.

Q: How to apply?

A: Interested youth can complete a written application and submit it by February 10, 2019.

Q: What is the time commitment?

A: Following the selection of 12 youth in February 2019, participants will meet weekly from beginning March 6, 2019 until the ten-day trip to Alberta, which will take place August 18-28, 2019. Prior to applying, youth are asked to ensure they can honour this time commitment. The group will participate in pre-expedition community projects including training, fundraising events, presentations and mentoring initiatives.
