CLENCH UPDATE

Attention Aamjiwnaang Band Members:

By way of a letter from the Negotiator for the Government of Canada, on June 19, 2020, Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada has accepted the terms of the “Final Settlement Agreement” between the First Nations. Canada agrees to pay thirty-five million, seven hundred twenty-eight thousand, three hundred fifty-four dollars (\$35,728,354) as compensation for the entire claim, apportionment being **52% (\$18,513,445.00) Aamjiwnaang First Nation** and 48% Chippewas of Kettle and Stony Point First Nation.

Since both Aamjiwnaang First Nation and the Chippewas of Kettle and Stony Point First Nation are beneficiaries of the claim, in order to achieve certainty and finality with respect to the entire claim, each must successfully ratify its respective settlement agreement in accordance with their respective voting guidelines in order for the entire ratification process for the settlement of the claim to be successful. Aamjiwnaang must agree to all the terms and conditions of this settlement agreement which authorizes and directs the Council to sign this settlement

agreement if, at the ratification vote, a minimum of 25% plus one of the voters vote in favour of the Settlement Agreement and those who vote in favour are a majority of those who vote.

Chief and Council of Aamjiwnaang hereby confirm and accept the terms of the apportioned global settlement offer presented by Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada as set out by the Negotiator, Specific Claims Branch.
