

ELIGIBILITY

Enbridge – Aamjiwnaang bursary will be awarded to members of Aamjiwnaang First Nation, who meet the following eligibility requirements:

- An Aamjiwnaang Band Member
- Achieve academic qualifications – obtained Ontario Secondary School Diploma or equivalent
- Enrolled full-time in a recognized/accredited post-secondary institution for Fall 2021 (minimum program length 1 year to maximum of 4 years)

REQUIREMENTS

- Applications must be fully completed; as incomplete applications will **NOT** be accepted.
- Application must be received by the specified deadline date to be considered for this bursary
- Attach a transcript from the 2020-2021 academic year
- Attach proof of enrollment/acceptance letter for chosen post-secondary institution
- Attach a letter explaining why you are requesting a bursary

BURSARY

- Five bursaries will be awarded to five students who meet the requirements.
- The amount of bursary disbursed in any given year will not exceed the amount of interest accumulated in the account to date.
- The maximum per student per year is \$2,000; however, this is subject to the review and discretion of the Selection Committee.
- If no student qualifies in any given year, the money stays in the fund for the following year.

Applications will be reviewed by the selection committee and will base its selection on the previous academic record of each student, as well as the student's general character, personal motivation, determination and financial need.

*** In Canada, the term "recognized" encompasses post-secondary institutions that offer credit course recognized by the Ministry of Colleges & Universities. Those wishing to attend a post-secondary institution in the United States must select an institution accredited by a regional institutional accrediting body. Applicants planning to attend non-recognized post-secondary institutions may be required by the Selection Committee to provide additional information upon review of their bursary application.*
