ELIGIBILITY

Shell – Aamjiwnaang bursary will be awarded to members of Aamjiwnaang First Nation, who meet the following eligibility requirements:

- An Aamjiwnaang Band Member
- Achieve academic qualifications – obtained Ontario Secondary School Diploma or equivalent
- Enrolled full-time in a recognized/accredited post-secondary institution for Fall 2021 in one of the following programs:
 - A **Mathematics and/or Health** based program
 - A **“Technology, Energy & Apprenticeship”** program including but not limited to:
 - Bio-Industrial Engineering Technology
 - Computer Programmer
 - Construction Carpentry Techniques
 - Construction Maintenance Electrician
 - Electrical Techniques
 - Electromechanical Engineering Technician
 - General Carpenter
 - General Machinist
 - Hairstylist Apprenticeship
 - Information Technology Professional
 - Social Worker
 - Internet Programming & Database Management
 - Millwright Mechanical Technician
 - Power Engineering Technology - Accelerated

- Attach proof of enrollment/acceptance letter for chosen post-secondary institution
- Attach a letter explaining why you consider yourself a strong candidate to receive this award.
 - Applicants will be assessed based on clarity and content of this statement along with academic standing.

BURSARY

- Three bursaries are available in the amount of \$1000.00/each

Applications will be approved by the selection committee and will base its selection on the previous academic record of each student, as well as the student’s general character, personal motivation, determination and financial need.

***Note:** *Chemical Production & Power Engineering Technology, Instrumentation & Control Engineering Technology and Mechanical Technician Maintenance do not qualify for this bursary, as there is a separate Shell bursary specific to those programs.*
