Remember Me: A National Day of Remembrance on September 30th

Bus will be leaving Community Centre at 3 pm **September 29th**
Leaving Ottawa at 5 pm on **September 30th**

Space for 24 ppl - Names to be drawn on September 21st

- In Ottawa due to the large crowd, they are encouraging attendees to be vaccinated.
- There will be **“NO”** access to washrooms on the bus due to Covid restrictions, we will be making stops for food and washroom breaks. Mask are required on the bus.
- Bring your own spending money - Hotel and small stipend for meals will be supplied.
- Your own Credit Card will be required for the Hotel room Security Deposit and any miscellaneous charges.
- During the Spirit Walk to Confederation Park (about 500 meters), they are calling for women to walk together and the men to support and elevate them as they carry the sacredness of motherhood and childhood. This to be led by Indigenous Grandmothers, Mothers, Daughters and Survivors. They are also asking for the women to wear their orange shirts, ribbon skirts, moccasins (if they have one to carry their feather)
- People are asked to bring lawn chairs, hats, water, food, medicines (sage/tobacco etc.) umbrella and hand sanitizer. Masks which will be mandatory, .
- Residential school/day school survivors can register on Eventbrite and may receive (limited amount of feathers) an eagle feather in recognition for their time spent at these schools during the first part of the ceremony on the 30th.
