The Governance Agreement is a historic step towards self-determination, recognizing the inherent right of the First Nation to govern itself in accordance with traditional values, and law in four key areas: **Elections, Citizenship, Language & Culture, and Operations and Management.**

Traditional Justice & Enforcement

Our community will be able to resolve disputes using restorative justice and traditional Anishinaabe processes. This includes creating laws for enforcement and appointing officers to uphold those laws, rooted in our values and culture.



Offences and Sanctions

The Nation can set fair penalties for breaking community laws. These can include culturally appropriate alternatives to fines or jail time, ensuring justice reflects Anishinaabe traditions.



Access to Information and Privacy

You have the right to know what your government is doing. This agreement ensures openness and transparency while protecting personal information—so your voice and privacy are respected.
